BACKGROUND: Over four decades, GHN has been a leading force, advocating for sexual health, HIV prevention, and inclusive sexual education. Join us as we gear up for our most significant milestone yet—a celebration of art's dynamic influence in shaking stigma, fostering inclusivity, and sparking crucial conversations about sexual health and education.

PROJECT SCOPE:

Two primary project components:

- **Historical Retrospective Exhibition:** Curating a vibrant collection showcasing Ireland's journey in HIV prevention and sexual health campaigns from the 70/80s to today.
- **Open Call for New Artworks:** Inviting artists, collectives, and organisations to create pieces that delve into sexual health, challenge stigma, and encapsulate the 2024 LGBTQ+ experience.

2. Ensure the selection aligns with project objectives and effectively engages the audience.
3. Ensure inclusivity, diverse representation, and nationwide involvement, facilitating participation from various LGBTQ or cultural centres and regions across Ireland.
4. Analyse current trends or gaps in artistic representations and leverage this understanding to encourage submissions that showcase the advancement of sexual health advocacy and contribute to fostering inclusive dialogue on related societal themes.
